#### **PARTIAL COMMISSIONERS COURT PARTICIPATION PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION (PUC) OPEN MEETING OF OCTOBER 22, 2010**

#### **BEING FOR PUC DOCKET NO. 38140; SOAH DOCKET NO. 473-10-4109 – APPLICATION OF ONCOR ELECTRIC DELIVERY COMPANY, LLC to AMEND a CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY (CCN) for the “Riley- Krum” 345-kV CREZ Transmission Line (Formerly Oklaunion to West Krum) in Archer, Clay, Cooke, Denton, Jack Montague, Wichita, Wilbarger, and Wise Counties**

On the above date, the Wise County Judge (Bill McElhaney) and two Wise County Commissioners (Commissioner Danny White – Precinct No. 1 and Commissioner Kevin Burns – Precinct No. 2) plan to be in attendance at the PUC Open Meeting referenced hereinabove, and whereat said Wise County Commissioners Court members who attend will actively participate as possible in any discussion and consideration of the PUC Commission in regards to the Commission’s *Final Order* of the Riley-Krum CCN Application Amendment’s Transmission Line Routing.

**Said Open Meeting will be conducted within the PUC Commissioners Hearing Room on the 7<sup>th</sup> Floor of the William B. Travis Building, 1200 North Congress Avenue, Austin, Texas. The Meeting will commence at 9:30 a.m. Friday, October 22, 2010, with several other Agenda Items, and the Riley-Krum CCN being listed on the Meeting Agenda as Item No. 8 (See Attachment – Page 2 of this Notice.)**

The Judge and attending Commissioners will be at this Open Meeting for the sole purposes of gathering and sharing information as possible, and to be a visible presence in the event the PUC Commission members need additional testimonial information and/or have questions for clarification of previously submitted Commissioners Court Resolution, Statement of Positions, and Merits Hearing testimony. In addition to the stated purposes mentioned heretofore, it is the opinion of the Wise County Commissioners Court that having approved representatives at this Meeting will also provide valuable up-to-date information of the ultimate outcome, and also to gain the ability to later inform the full Commissioners Court and Wise County citizens on the Final Order as concluded by the Commission - as well as become aware of any possible upcoming issues and challenges that could otherwise affect Wise County in the future.

There will be no other type County business conducted or discussed nor any County decisions or action taken by any of the Commissioners Court attendees other than the associated discretion of the attendees as was previously approved in the full Court’s convening Resolution and Ratifications of the Court’s position and the attending members’ approved participation, to include while they are traveling to and from and/or participating in this PUC Open Meeting referenced and described herein.
