8. Consider on act on resolution designating Wise County as a Sanctuary for the Unborn. (JDC)
9. Discuss plat submittals. Take necessary action. (JDC)
10. Receive annual Wise County audit presentation. Take any necessary action. (JDC) (AM)
11. Consider speed limit change on a portion of Old Decatur Road/Old Alvord Highway. Take any necessary action. (KB)
