WISE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT MEETING

On this the 17th day of June, A.D., 2019 at 9:00 A.M. came on to be had a Public Hearing of the Commissioners' Court of Wise County, Texas held in the County Court at Law Court Room (3rd) Floor in County Courthouse of said County in the town of Decatur with the following members present and presiding:

County Judge Clark votes aye on all agenda items unless otherwise indicated.

Clark opened the public hearing at 9:03 AM. All court members were present except Burns and Lamance.

Clark asked Commissioners Court Attorney Thomas Aaberg to review the Taking Impact Assessment (TIA).

Aaberg told the court that according to the way the Attorney General lays out the questions there are no takings. Aaberg stated that everything the county did is for regulation of safety off of roadways; modification of the flood plain; and, standardization of administrative processes through Wise County Development Services Public Works Director Joey Highfill.

Aaberg told the court that the items that were put to a stricter test are the recreational vehicle (RV) communities based on county determined safety reasons for emergency services; and, previously exempt subdivisions have more detail so the county can keep up with what is going on roadways as those subdivisions develop further and increase stress on county infrastructure. Aaberg told the court that when these were put through the Attorney General's test they still did not come up to TIA standard.

Clark opened the public hearing for questions from the public. None were made.

Clark closed the public hearing at 9:14 AM there being no further discussion to be had.

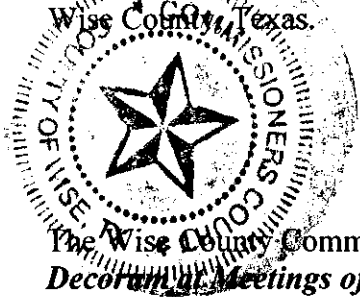
